PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD 03/24/2024

Reading 1 Isaiah 50:4-7; Phil 2:6-11; Mk. 141 -15:47

My friends, we have just heard The Greatest Story Ever Told. And **our hearts break** for what Jesus had to go through. Here was an innocent man...our God in fact...being mistreated and falsely accused and mocked and well...it's hard to even say the words. And he did it all for us. And for no other reason other than **he loves us**. Imagine that.

And yet, this Greatest Story Ever Told is <u>not</u> simply about Jesus...no matter how misguided that may sound. The story we just heard shows us that and so, we are invited to trust, to take Jesus' hand to walk with Jesus wherever he leads. Not in fear and despair, but in hope. It starts with a single step. Not alone...but with Jesus. Let's make that sacred walk this week.
